Presentation title:	<p>Policy Brief on Sustainable Growth. Recommendations on Energy, Climate and Environmental Policies</p>	
<p>This paper is a presentation of the proposals made by a group of civil society activists and professionals from six European countries (France, Germany, Greece, Italy, Portugal and Spain) aiming to promote a sustainable, inclusive and climate-friendly growth path.</p> <p>During the years 2016-18 the Berlin-based think tank Das Progressive Zentrum organized the trans-European civil society project 'DIALOGUE ON EUROPE'. The overall project has been supported by the German Federal Foreign Office.</p> <p>Within this framework, four so-called 'Thinking Labs' have worked to deliver fresh ideas and to independently elaborate concrete policy recommendations. The output were policy recommendations on four European key areas: Migration & Integration, Populism, Social Cohesion, and Sustainable Growth.</p> <p>The Thinking Lab for Sustainable Growth focused on Innovation and a 'Greener' Economy as drivers for sustainable well-being and a fairer society.</p> <p>The recommendations were stated briefly as follows:</p> <p>Future energy and transport systems will not only be emissions-free: they also have to embrace technological trends in information and communications technology. Regulatory and policy signals regarding a decisive shift to renewable energy and improved energy efficiency are sorely missing.
